Air Navigation Services Employee ANSE

Responsible for the safe and efficient management of air traffic

Air navigation services employees (ANSEs) work primarily in air traffic management (ATM) and in aeronautical information management (AIM).

They provide important information to

the stakeholders in the Swiss aviation industry (airlines, pilots, airport authorities, air traffic controllers) to ensure that the flow of air traffic is safe and efficient.

You ensure an optimum flow of air traffic through the airspace controlled by Skyguide. You are responsible for receiving, transmitting and relaying aviation reports. You support pilots by providing them with all the relevant information, such as airport conditions, weather reports and any potential risks, so that

they can prepare effectively for their flight. You edit flight plans and check that every detail is correct.

- Flow management (Geneva and Dübendorf)
- Communication centre (Geneva)
- Aeronautical information management (Dübendorf)
- Flight information centre (Geneva and Dübendorf)
